GRE Draft Policy on Lab Coats

(1) Labcoats (and other protective equipment) should always be worn when handling hazardous materials, performing hazardous techniques using these materials or when in an environment when exposure to such materials is a significant possibility.

(2) Wherever feasible, handling of hazardous materials should be restricted to the specific areas designated.

(3) Labcoats should not be worn in communal areas and areas where food and drink is likely to be consumed.

(4) Lab coats should be washed on a regular basis.
