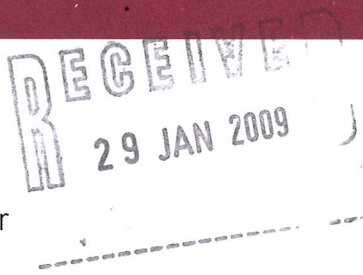

**GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS (CONTAINED USE) REGULATIONS  
2000, AS AMENDED**

**REVISED CONSENT**

Thank you for your notification dated 19 December 2008 under Regulation 18(2) of the above Regulations, of your intention to perform activities involving genetically modified micro-organisms (GMMs).

The Competent Authority consents to the activities as specified in the notification GM GM6/96.1 as amended by GM6/95.2 and GM6/96.1a entitled "EVALUATION OF CHEMOTHERAPEUTIC TARGETS IN PARASITIC PROTOZOA" involving GMMs of Class 3. The derogations applied for under Regulation 25 are agreed in full. The derogations from full containment are listed in the appendix.

This letter does not imply endorsement by the Competent Authority of any physical containment and associated safety precautions at your centre, or that the measures you have taken are sufficient to comply with the Regulations and other relevant legislation. HSE inspectors may have additional observations and requirements when conducting site inspections under the Health & Safety at Work etc Act.

Under Regulation 15 this Consent may be revoked or varied at any time. Regulation 15(2) and (3) requires that the Competent Authority be kept informed of any changes to the notified details.

**APPENDIX TO GM GM6/96.1 as amended by GM6/05.2 and GM6/96.1a  
RELATING TO EVALUATION OF CHEMOTHERAPEUTIC TARGETS IN  
PARASITIC PROTOZOA**

The Competent Authority agrees that the following containment measures listed under Schedule 8 of the Regulations may be omitted:-

Part II, Table 1a

- 2 Laboratory: sealable for fumigation
- 5 Negative pressure relative to the pressure of immediate surroundings
- 6 Extract and input air from the laboratory shall be HEPA filtered

Part II, Table 1c

- 9 (New Measure) Infected animals held in isolators

Under Regulation 29, you may appeal against the decision of the Competent Authority. For premises/activities in England or Wales the appeal should be made to the Secretary of State. For those in Scotland, it should be made to both the Secretary of State and the Scottish Minister.
