# **?**Fire

If you hear a very loud, continuous siren, please leave the building immediately by the nearest fire exit. Fire exit routes bear the green & white exit, or 'running man', signs. Do not use the lifts. Go to the Fire Assembly Point indicated by your Host at the start of your visit. If separated from your Host, remake contact outside. Fire Wardens are there to assist you, if necessary. Do not reenter the building unless authorised to do so by your Host or a Fire Warden. If you hear repeated short bursts of a very loud siren, this indicates that a fire evacuation is in progress in an adjacent building. You are not required to evacuate until the siren begins to sound continuously, but be prepared to evacuate. If you discover a fire, please activate the nearest break-glass point immediately and exit the building as above.
